# Membership Categories Explained

---

## Full Membership

---

A Full Member is a male or female member who has paid an entry fee and is entitled to use all facilities of the Club on all seven days of the week subject to any General Committee restrictions under the Bye-laws. All Full Members are entitled to one vote at General Meetings and are eligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles

---

## Seven Day Membership

---

A Seven Day Member is a male or female member who is entitled to use all the facilities of the club on all seven days of the week, but has not paid an entry fee. This category is in addition to Full Membership where an entry fee has been paid. All Seven Day Members are entitled to one vote at General Meetings and are eligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles.

## Intermediate & Student

*All Intermediate & Student ages to be taken  
1st January*

---

An Intermediate Member is a male or female member between the ages of 18 and 29 years, and a Student Member is a male or female member over the age of 18 years still receiving full time education. Both are entitled to use all the facilities of the Club on all 7 days of the week subject to any General Committee restrictions under the Bye-laws. Intermediate and Student Members are not entitled to vote at General Meetings and are ineligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles. Subscription rates are % pro rata from age 18 to 29.

---

## Junior Membership

*All Junior ages to be taken on 1st  
January.*

---

A Junior Member is a male or female member under the age of 18 years on the 1st January in the calendar year in question and is for 1 year only. Continued Junior Membership is conditional on an annual assessment by the Junior Organiser and with the approval of the General Committee. Junior Members may use the Club facilities on all 7 days of the week subject to the Rules of the Junior Section and also subject to any General Committee restrictions under the bye-laws. Junior Members are not entitled to vote at General Meetings and, are ineligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles. Different subscription rates apply for Under 10 years, 11 years, 12 - 15 years, 16 - 18 years

---

## Trial Membership

---

Trial Membership entitles the member to use all the facilities of the club on all 7 days of the week for a period of 3 months after which they must decide to either revert to Full or Seven Day Membership or leave. Trial Members will be subject to the Club's standard joining procedure, will not be eligible to vote at General Meetings or to hold any office

---

## International Membership

---

International Membership entitles the member to use all the facilities of the club on all seven days of the week for a minimum period of 3 months. Their permanent address must be outside the United Kingdom, they must be an existing member of a golf club in their home country and have a current handicap. A letter of introduction from their current club will be required. International members will not be eligible to vote at General Meetings or to hold any office.

---

## Country Membership

---

All persons applying for this category must have been past members of Broadway Golf Club holding Full, Seven Day or Junior membership for at least five years. The said applicant of this category must reside a minimum distance of 40 miles from Broadway Golf Club. The said applicant of this category must hold a CONGU handicap. Places in this category will be limited to 10 in number. Playing privileges will be the same as full members but limited to 15 times per year, excess rounds will be charged at the with member rate. Entry to winter league or knock out competition will be allowed at the rate of £15 per round

---

## Social Membership

---

A Social Member is a male or female non playing member who may use all the facilities of the Club except the golf course unless on payment of the appropriate green fee on all 7 days of the week subject to any General Committee restrictions under the bye-laws. Social Members are not entitled to vote at General Meetings and are ineligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles

---

## Life Membership

---

A Life Member is a Full Member entitled to all privileges of membership without payment of the annual subscription, nominated by the General Committee and elected by the members in a General Meeting subject to 75% of the votes cast.

Those members having reached the age of 75 years and completed 25 years of full membership, or, have contributed substantially to the well being of the club and have completed 25 years of full membership, may resign their Full Membership, and subject to General Committee approval, be granted Honorary Life Social Membership of the Club. Subject to General Committee approval, this concession may be granted retrospectively.

All Life Members are entitled to one vote at General Meetings and are eligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles.

---

## Honorary Membership

---

An Honorary Member is a member who has his/her subscription or part subscription waived at the discretion of the General Committee.

An Honorary 50/75 Member is a member who has completed 50 years as a Full Member and who has attained the age of 75 years. His/her subscription is waived, and is entitled to all privileges of membership.

All Honorary Members are entitled to one vote at General Meetings and are eligible for election as Directors under Clause 27 of the Articles.

*If you would like to apply for any type of membership please complete an application form and return to the office. Upon submission of your form your name will be placed on the Club notice board for two weeks.*

*You will then be contacted to arrange a mutually convenient time for an informal interview, after which you should be offered membership. Membership will commence only after payment of the appropriate fees.*
